

Frequently Asked Questions

1. How can I participate in the 2022 Walk To End Epilepsy?

Visit our website epilepsyct.com/events/walk/registration to register. We have 7 locations throughout Connecticut to choose from this year:

Saturday, May 7th: Cove Island Park - Stamford, CT

Sunday, May 8th: Parmelee Farm - Killingworth, CT

Saturday, May 14th: Rocky Neck State Park - East Lyme, CT

Sunday, May 15th: Winding Trails - Farmington, CT and Harrybrooke Park - New Milford, CT

Saturday, May 21st: High Plains Community Center - Orange, CT

Sunday, May 22nd: Crandall Park - Tolland, CT

2. What about COVID-19?

As of now, we are planning to host in-person walks in May. That is subject to change based on guidance from the CDC and the State of Connecticut. We will announce any changes to the walk schedule on our website and social media pages. All CDC and State of Connecticut guidelines will be followed at our in-person walks to keep participants, volunteers, and EFCT staff safe. We are asking that participants walk in small, safe groups. All participants should follow CDC guidelines and local health recommendations when deciding to walk with those outside of their household.



3. Is there a cost to participate in the Walk?

There is NO FEE to register for any of our walk locations in Connecticut. However, every person regardless of age that is planning to walk with us must register!

Please note: Each participant should register themselves individually! This is necessary so each participant can accept the terms of the liability waiver and provide a valid email address so they can receive details about the event. Those under 18 that are walking must be accompanied by an adult and have an adult agree to the liability waiver during the registration process.

4. How do I get a Walk to End Epilepsy t-shirt?

Registered walkers who make a \$20 donation will receive an official Walk to End Epilepsy t-shirt. Make sure you select your t-shirt size on the registration page!



5. How will I receive my Walk to End Epilepsy t-shirt?

Your shirt will be mailed to you directly prior to the walk. Please select your correct t-shirt size when prompted on the registration page.

6. How can I start a team?

Starting a team is easy! Just select the "Start A Team" button on the registration page and fill in the information requested. You will be able to add a team picture, story, and donation goal. Once you have started a new team, be sure to ask friends, family, and co-workers to join your team and support the epilepsy community.

7. How can I fundraise?
