

1. How can I participate in the 2021 Walk To End Epilepsy?

- Sunday May 23rd: Winding Trails - Farmington, CT


2. What about COVID-19?

As of now, we are planning to host in-person walks in May. That is subject to change based on guidance from the CDC and the State of Connecticut. We will announce any changes to the walk schedule on our website and social media pages. All CDC and State of Connecticut guidelines will be followed at our in-person walks to keep participants, volunteers, and EFCT staff safe. We are asking that participants walk in small, safe groups. All participants should follow CDC guidelines and local health recommendations when deciding to walk with those outside of their household.

3. Is there a cost to participate in the Walk?

Based on new guidelines from the National Walk to End Epilepsy, there is NO FEE to register for any of our walk locations in Connecticut. However, every person regardless of age that is planning to walk with us must register!

Please note: Each participant should register themselves individually! This is necessary so each participant can accept the terms of the liability waiver and provide a valid email address so they can receive details about the event. Those under 18 that are walking must be accompanied by an adult and have an adult agree to the liability waiver during the registration process.



4. Do I get a t-shirt when I register?

We want all members of the community to walk with us, but we cannot host these events and provide the resources for the epilepsy community without your help.

We encourage every walker to make a personal donation and commit to raising funds to help us support the epilepsy community.

Registered walkers who make a \$50 donation will receive an official Walk to End Epilepsy t-shirt.

5. How will I receive my event participant t-shirt?

Your shirt will be mailed to you directly prior to the walk. Please select your correct t-shirt size when prompted on the registration page.

6. How can I start a team?




